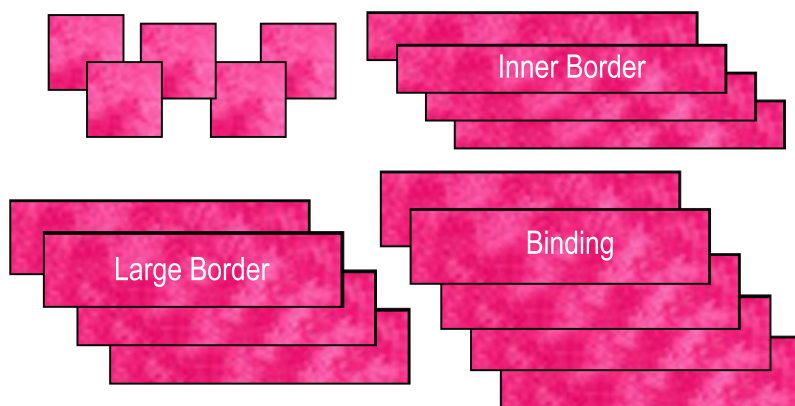
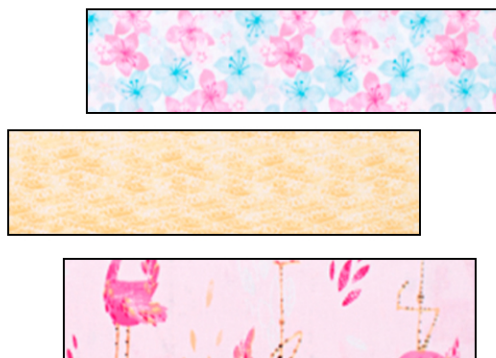


# Peeking Pinwheels

This easy block pinwheels peek out once assembled! It works great with any 2 1/2" strips!  
For the pictured quilt, 42"x42", I used one 20 strip jelly roll and 1 1/2 yds of bright pink.

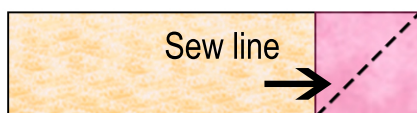
Cut the 2 1/2" strips into 6 1/2" pieces.  
You can get 6 pieces per 40/42" strip.  
I left four half strips uncut for the border accents.

From the bright pink cut 72 - 2 1/2" squares,  
4 - 1 1/2" x WOF for small inner border,  
4 - 2 1/2" x WOF to be used for large borders and  
5 - 2 1/2" strips x WOF for binding.



With a 6 1/2" strip, place a 2 1/2" pink square on one end, right sides together. Stitch from the upper right corner down to the bottom left corner of the 2 1/2" square. Fold the triangle open and press. Repeat to make 72 strips in the EXACT SAME WAY.

For the large borders, I randomly cut the length of the pink and sew onto 20" strips I set aside. Once assembled I trimmed them to a length of 42" for the outer border. Binding with the bright pink finishes framing the borders of the quilt.



You will have 72 sewn strips and 36 plain.  
Assemble the block as shown below.
